Save Your Laptop

Another option is anti-theft software that can track its location without any external monitoring. nTracker is a program that sits on your computer where thieves can't find it. If your computer is stolen, as soon as it can make a connection nTracker will invisibly send an e-mail with its exact location. Meanwhile, your data is protected behind a password—and three wrong guesses set off an alarm and activate a screen saver with whatever contact information you want displayed.
